

# SUGGESTED ITEMS TO BRING TO SCHOOL (BOARDING STUDENTS ONLY)

It is important that you bring enough clothes for the school year, while at the same time not over-packing — remember, you will have to share a room. Along with the neat, clean and appropriate attire for our traditional day-to-day expectations, your clothing list must include:

## BOYS

Slacks

Ties

## GIRLS

Slacks  
Dresses, Skirts

Shoes, Sneakers, Boots  
Rain Gear  
Shorts, Sweatpants  
Winter Coat

(All clothing should be marked with name tags.)

\* All Freshmen and Sophomores must bring a sleeping bag for Orientation camping trip.

## OTHER SUGGESTED ITEMS:

Pillows  
Sheets (size: 36" wide, 80" long), pillow cases & towels  
(unless you are purchasing the linen service through E & R Laundry)  
Toiletries (bucket or toilet kit to carry items in)  
Desk Lamp  
Posters/Decorations for Room  
Broom  
\*Alarm Clock  
Stereo, Radio (NO TV)  
Extra Blanket  
Writing Paper/Stamps  
Pictures of Friends & Family  
Pencils/Pens/ Markers  
Footlocker or safe deposit type lock-up for valuables.

You can purchase many of the standard supplies in our school store, although you may want to pick up some of the items initially at home. Items from home can be shipped through U.P.S. or the U.S. Mail, if you have forgotten something.

Nails, tacks and tape are not to be used on walls. Posters, etc. may be secured to wooden molding.

## ITEMS YOU MAY NOT BRING:

TV's, cooking appliances, refrigerators, B.B. Guns, Paintball Guns, firearms, knives of any type, or archery equipment. These will be confiscated and not returned.
